SELF-SERVICE HOMESCHOOL MATH PROGRAM

Curriculum Access, Subscription, License, Terms, and Program Policies

Effective Academic Year: 2026-2027

This Curriculum Access, Subscription, License, Terms, and Program Policies document ("Agreement") governs enrollment in the Self-Service Homeschool Math Program offered by Infinity - The Math Institute ("Infinity").

By enrolling a student, checking an electronic acknowledgment box, submitting payment, or using the Self-Service program after receiving these terms, the enrolling parent or legal guardian ("Parent") acknowledges that the Parent has read, understands, and agrees to these terms on behalf of the Parent and enrolled student ("Student").

This Agreement explains what Infinity agrees to provide, the responsibilities of the Parent and Student, the terms governing access to Infinity's curriculum, and which services or accommodations Infinity may provide at its discretion.

1. What Is Required and What Is Discretionary

Throughout this Agreement, the words "will" and "shall" describe obligations or standard program features that Infinity agrees to provide, subject to the terms of this Agreement.

The words "may," "can," "generally," "typically," "when available," "at Infinity's discretion," and similar language describe services, accommodations, exceptions, or decisions that are not guaranteed.

Infinity may make reasonable exceptions because of unusual circumstances. An exception does not change the underlying policy, create a right to future exceptions, or require Infinity to provide the same exception to another family.

PART I. PROGRAM AND ENROLLMENT

2. Program Purpose

The Infinity Self-Service Homeschool Math Program provides families with a complete mathematics curriculum and instructional system that a Parent, homeschool teacher, or other authorized adult can use to teach the enrolled Student.

Infinity provides the curriculum, instructional materials, assignments, assessments, answer keys, and other resources described in this Agreement.

The Self-Service program does not include regularly scheduled live instruction from Infinity. The Parent or other authorized instructor is responsible for teaching, supervising, pacing, grading, and managing the Student's day-to-day mathematics education unless Infinity expressly provides a separate service.

Parents remain responsible for the Student's overall homeschool program and for complying with applicable homeschool laws where the Student resides.

3. Available Courses

For the 2026-2027 academic year, Infinity offers the following primary Self-Service Homeschool courses:

Foundations of Middle School Math ("Basic Math")

Builds the mathematical foundation students need after elementary mathematics and before Pre-Algebra.

Pre-Algebra

Strengthens middle school mathematics and prepares students for Algebra 1.

Algebra 1

Provides a complete Algebra 1 foundation and prepares students for higher-level mathematics.

Geometry, Algebra 2, and Precalculus are planned for 2027 or later but are not guaranteed until Infinity formally makes them available.

Course placement is based primarily on mathematical readiness rather than age or grade level.

4. Placement Assessment

Students are expected to complete an Infinity placement assessment before beginning the Self-Service program unless Infinity determines that sufficient placement information is already available.

Infinity will use the assessment and other relevant academic information to recommend the course it believes is most appropriate for the Student.

If later performance indicates that the Student may be working at an inappropriate level, the Parent may contact Infinity to discuss another placement.

Placement recommendations are educational recommendations and do not guarantee any particular academic result.

PART II. SELF-PACED COURSE STRUCTURE

5. Self-Paced Progression

Unlike the Full-Service Homeschool program, Self-Service is not tied to a September-through-May instructional calendar.

Students progress through the course at their own pace while maintaining an active monthly subscription.

Each course contains 11 units. The Student progresses from Unit 1 through Unit 11 in sequence.

The Parent is responsible for maintaining an appropriate instructional schedule and ensuring that the Student completes the required lessons, assignments, and assessments.

6. Initial Course Access

When Self-Service course access begins, the Student will ordinarily have access to Units 1, 2, and 3.

Access is intentionally limited to portions of the course rather than providing the entire curriculum at one time.

This rolling-access structure is part of Infinity's program design and intellectual-property protection.

7. Rolling Three-Unit Access

As the Student progresses, Infinity will provide sequential access to additional units.

Under the standard progression:

- The Student ordinarily begins with Units 1, 2, and 3.
- When Unit 3 is completed, Unit 1 closes and Unit 4 opens.
- When Unit 4 is completed, Unit 2 closes and Unit 5 opens.
- This process continues through the remainder of the course.

The purpose is to maintain access to approximately three active instructional units at a time while allowing the Student to continue progressing through the complete 11-unit course.

Completion may be determined through the course platform, required assignments or assessments, or another progression method established by Infinity.

Families may not demand access to the complete course library at one time.

8. Unit Review Access

After a completed unit closes, the designated Unit Review lesson or review portion from that unit will remain available for continued reference.

The remainder of a closed unit may no longer be accessible once the Student has progressed beyond the applicable rolling-access window.

9. Course Completion and Next Course

The Student completes the course after completing all 11 units and the required course components.

The Parent must notify Infinity when the Student completes the course so that course progression and continued enrollment can be determined.

Unless the Parent elects to discontinue Self-Service at that time, Infinity will transition the Student into the next appropriate available course and the monthly subscription will continue without interruption.

If the Parent elects to discontinue Self-Service upon completion of the course, no additional cancellation payment will be required beyond amounts already due.

PART III. SELF-SERVICE CURRICULUM MATERIALS

10. Core Materials

Infinity will provide or designate the Self-Service materials applicable to the Student's course, including:

- Student textbook or equivalent student lesson materials
- Parent/teacher lecture scripts and lesson plans
- Homework assignments
- Lesson quizzes
- Unit examinations
- Midterm examination
- Final examination
- Study guides and review materials
- Applicable answer keys and solutions

Materials may be delivered through an online platform, downloadable files, electronic documents, or another format selected by Infinity.

11. Answer Keys and Teacher Materials

Answer keys, solutions, assessments, and teacher-facing materials are provided for use by the Parent or authorized instructor in teaching and evaluating the enrolled Student.

Parents are responsible for protecting restricted teacher materials from unauthorized Student access when appropriate.

Answer keys, examinations, and other restricted materials may not be publicly posted, shared, sold, distributed, or provided to unauthorized users.

12. Instructional Videos

Infinity may provide instructional videos as supplemental resources.

The Infinity video library is being developed and may not be complete when a Student enrolls. Some lessons or units may have video instruction while others do not.

Additional videos may be added during the Student's subscription.

The absence of a video for a particular lesson does not mean that required Self-Service curriculum materials have not been provided and does not create a right to a refund.

The student textbook, lecture materials, lesson plans, assignments, assessments, and related instructional resources remain the core of the Self-Service program.

PART IV. PARENT AND STUDENT RESPONSIBILITIES

13. Parent-Led Instruction

Self-Service is designed for families who wish to teach and manage the Infinity curriculum themselves.

The Parent or another authorized adult is responsible for:

- Teaching or supervising lessons
- Establishing the Student's schedule
- Monitoring Student progress
- Assigning and reviewing homework
- Administering assessments appropriately
- Using answer keys and teacher materials responsibly
- Providing additional explanation or assistance when necessary
- Maintaining any homeschool records required by the family's jurisdiction

Infinity does not guarantee individualized live teaching, tutoring, homework help, or direct academic intervention under the Self-Service subscription unless separately purchased or expressly included.

14. Student Responsibilities

Students are expected to complete the course materials honestly and make a meaningful effort to learn the material.

Students should complete lessons, homework, quizzes, examinations, and other assignments in the sequence and manner directed by the Parent, authorized instructor, or Infinity course materials.

15. Academic Honesty

Parents are responsible for administering assessments in a manner that reasonably reflects the Student's own work.

Students should not receive unauthorized help, use restricted answer keys, have another person complete work, copy solutions, or otherwise misrepresent another person's work as their own.

Because Self-Service instruction and assessment occur primarily outside Infinity's direct supervision, Infinity cannot independently verify the conditions under which every assignment or assessment is completed.

PART V. GRADING, RECORDS, AND HOMESCHOOL DOCUMENTATION

16. Parent Responsibility for Grading

Unless Infinity expressly provides otherwise through the course platform or another service, the Parent or authorized instructor is responsible for grading and evaluating the Student's Self-Service work using the provided answer keys, assessments, and instructional materials.

Automated scoring or progress information may be available for some materials when supported by the platform.

Infinity does not guarantee that every assignment or assessment will be automatically graded.

17. Self-Service Records

The Self-Service program provides curriculum materials and may provide platform-based progress or completion information.

Unless expressly offered as part of a separate service, Self-Service does not include the same Infinity-maintained attendance records, instructional-hour reports, quarterly reports, teacher-issued grades, or Final Course Record Packet provided through the Full-Service Homeschool program.

Parents are responsible for maintaining the Student's homeschool records, grades, attendance, instructional hours, portfolios, transcripts, and other documentation required for their educational purposes or jurisdiction.

18. Certificates and Third-Party Records

Self-Service enrollment does not include an Infinity-issued grade, transcript, attendance record, certificate, diploma, academic credit, or other credential unless Infinity expressly offers that item as part of the applicable Self-Service program.

Parents remain responsible for determining how Self-Service coursework is documented within their homeschool program.

PART VI. HOMESCHOOL STATUS AND LEGAL RESPONSIBILITY

19. Parent Responsibility for Homeschool Compliance

Infinity may serve Self-Service families throughout the United States and internationally.

Parents remain responsible for understanding and complying with all homeschool and education requirements applicable where the Student resides.

Infinity provides mathematics curriculum and educational materials but does not provide legal advice or assume responsibility for the family's overall homeschool compliance.

Parent responsibilities may include:

- Filing required homeschool notices or registrations
- Maintaining attendance and instructional-hour records
- Tracking required subjects
- Preparing grades, transcripts, or portfolios
- Arranging evaluations or standardized testing
- Determining homeschool credit
- Satisfying compulsory education requirements
- Completing other government, school, or legal requirements

20. Infinity Is Not the Student's School of Record

Infinity - The Math Institute provides mathematics curriculum and educational services but is not presently an accredited K-12 school or diploma-granting institution.

Self-Service enrollment does not make Infinity the Student's legal school of record.

The Parent remains responsible for determining how Infinity curriculum, assessments, course descriptions, and related materials may lawfully be used within the Student's homeschool program.

PART VII. TECHNOLOGY AND COURSE ACCESS

21. Technology Requirements

Because Self-Service is delivered primarily online, the family is responsible for providing reliable internet access, a suitable device, access to required platforms, and the ability to view and use course materials.

The Parent is responsible for the Student's internet service, device functionality, software compatibility, file storage, printing when desired, and other home technology.

Personal technology problems do not automatically create a right to a refund or additional subscription period, although Infinity may provide a discretionary accommodation when appropriate.

22. Account Security

The Parent is responsible for maintaining the security of the family's Infinity account and login credentials.

Account credentials may not be shared with unrelated students, families, tutors, schools, pods, microschools, or other unauthorized users.

The Parent should notify Infinity promptly if unauthorized access is suspected.

Infinity may suspend or restrict access when it reasonably believes an account is being shared, compromised, or used in violation of this Agreement.

PART VIII. MONTHLY SUBSCRIPTION, PAYMENT, AND CANCELLATION

23. Standard Subscription Price

The standard Self-Service Homeschool subscription price is:

\$79 per month

Self-Service is offered on a monthly subscription basis only.

There is no standard annual or full-course upfront payment option.

24. Promotional Pricing

Infinity may periodically offer promotional pricing, including rates such as \$59 per month, discount codes, Founding Family pricing, or other special offers.

Promotions may have eligibility requirements, expiration dates, or other conditions.

Unless expressly stated otherwise, promotional subscriptions remain subject to this Agreement.

25. Recurring Monthly Billing

The Self-Service subscription renews monthly and continues from course to course until canceled in accordance with this Agreement or otherwise ended by Infinity.

The Parent authorizes recurring monthly billing using the payment method provided during enrollment.

The Student may progress through the curriculum at the Student's own pace. The amount of curriculum completed during a billing period does not alter the monthly subscription charge.

Completing one course does not automatically end the subscription. Unless the Parent elects to discontinue service upon course completion, the Student will move into the next appropriate available Infinity course and monthly billing will continue.

26. Cancellation

The Parent must notify Infinity to cancel the Self-Service subscription.

If the Parent chooses to cancel before the Student completes the current course, one additional monthly subscription payment will be due at the applicable subscription rate. That payment will be the family's final required monthly payment.

The Student will retain Self-Service access through the final paid subscription period. At the end of that period, the subscription will terminate and no additional recurring payments will be charged.

If the Parent chooses to discontinue Self-Service when the Student completes a course, no additional cancellation payment will be required. The Parent must notify Infinity at the time of course completion that the Student will not continue into the next course.

If the Parent does not elect to discontinue service at course completion, the Student will transition into the next appropriate available course and the monthly subscription will continue.

After the subscription ends, course access may end, including access to active units, retained Unit Review materials, teacher resources, assessments, videos, and other subscription content.

If the family later returns to Self-Service, access, placement, pricing, and course progression will be subject to Infinity's then-current policies, platform capabilities, and course availability.

27. No Refunds

Self-Service monthly subscription payments, including any final cancellation payment, are nonrefundable once processed except where a refund is required by applicable law.

There are no prorated refunds for:

- Canceling during a billing period
- Failing to use the program
- Completing little or no coursework during the month
- Changes in the family's schedule
- Technology problems within the family's control
- Failure to download, view, or use available materials
- Lack of a supplemental video for a particular lesson

Infinity may choose to provide a credit, extension, or other accommodation in exceptional circumstances, but any such accommodation is discretionary and does not change the no-refund policy.

28. Nonpayment

Failure to make a required subscription payment may result in suspension or termination of course access.

Infinity may attempt to process a failed payment again or allow a reasonable opportunity to update payment information.

Any discretionary grace period does not waive amounts properly due.

PART IX. INTELLECTUAL PROPERTY AND LICENSE

29. Ownership of Infinity Materials

Infinity's curriculum and educational materials are proprietary intellectual property.

Infinity retains all applicable rights in its:

- Textbooks and lessons
- Lecture scripts and lesson plans
- Homework and practice materials
- Quizzes and examinations
- Study guides and answer keys
- Videos and graphics
- Curriculum structure and sequencing
- Teaching methods and instructional materials
- Course documents and branded materials

Subscription access does not transfer ownership of any Infinity curriculum or material.

30. Limited Individual Educational License

A standard Self-Service subscription provides a limited, revocable, non-transferable right to use the applicable Infinity materials solely to educate the enrolled Student.

The Parent or authorized instructor may use the materials to teach that Student.

The standard subscription does not authorize use of the materials to teach unrelated students, operate a tutoring service, teach a pod or microschool, provide classroom instruction to a group, resell curriculum, or operate another educational business.

Additional students may require separate enrollments or an approved group license.

31. Pods, Microschools, Schools, and Group Use

Families or organizations wishing to use Infinity materials with multiple unrelated students, homeschool pods, microschools, tutoring groups, schools, educational organizations, or other group settings must contact Infinity regarding an appropriate group or institutional license.

A standard Self-Service subscription does not provide a group-use license.

Group pricing, access, permitted usage, and other terms may differ from the standard individual Self-Service program.

32. Prohibited Copying, Sharing, and Circumvention

Without Infinity's prior written permission, users may not:

- Sell or redistribute Infinity materials
- Publicly upload or post course content
- Share answer keys or restricted assessments
- Share account credentials with unauthorized users
- Reproduce materials for unrelated students
- Record or copy protected video content for redistribution
- Systematically download, scrape, archive, or copy the complete course library
- Attempt to bypass or defeat rolling unit-access restrictions
- Circumvent technical controls used to limit access
- Create unauthorized commercial derivative materials
- Use Infinity content to create or operate a competing educational product or service

Reasonable personal printing or use for the enrolled Student's education is permitted when the course platform or material allows it.

Violation of these restrictions may result in immediate suspension or termination of access and may subject the responsible party to other available legal remedies.

33. Rolling Access Is a Material Program Condition

The three-unit rolling-access structure is an intentional condition of the Self-Service subscription.

Purchasing a subscription does not create a right to obtain, download, copy, or permanently retain all 11 instructional units simultaneously.

A family that does not agree to the rolling-access structure should not enroll in the Self-Service program.

PART X. RESULTS AND PROGRAM LIMITATIONS

34. No Guarantee of Academic Outcome

Infinity is committed to providing high-quality mathematics curriculum and instructional resources, but Student outcomes depend on factors outside Infinity's control, including instruction provided at home, Student effort, prior preparation, pacing, completed work, study habits, testing conditions, and individual circumstances.

Infinity does not guarantee any particular grade, assessment or standardized-test score, level of improvement, future course placement, school or college admission, academic credit, diploma eligibility, or other educational or career outcome.

35. Third-Party Acceptance

Infinity does not guarantee how any state, country, school, district, evaluator, college, accreditor, or other third party will recognize or accept Self-Service coursework, Parent-issued grades, assessments, course materials, or other records.

Those decisions are controlled by the applicable third party.

PART XI. OPERATIONAL AND LEGAL TERMS

36. Reasonable Program Changes

Infinity may make reasonable changes to course platforms, curriculum delivery, access procedures, assessment formats, technology, or administrative systems when necessary to improve or operate the Self-Service program.

Infinity will not use this provision to eliminate the essential Self-Service curriculum access purchased by the family while continuing to charge for a materially different service.

37. Platform or Service Interruptions

Infinity will not be considered in breach of this Agreement for temporary interruptions caused by circumstances reasonably outside its control, including internet or platform failures, natural disasters, severe weather, government action, public emergencies, power failures, or comparable events.

Infinity will make reasonable efforts to restore access when practical.

38. Communication

Parents are responsible for keeping their contact and payment information current.

Infinity may communicate through email, text, telephone, the course platform, parent portal, or other reasonable electronic means.

39. Discretionary Exceptions and No Waiver

Infinity may make reasonable exceptions because of unusual circumstances.

An exception does not permanently change the policy, create a right to future exceptions, require the same accommodation for another family, or waive Infinity's right to enforce the original policy later.

Any permanent modification to a family's contractual obligations must be confirmed in writing by Infinity.

40. Governing Law

Infinity - The Math Institute is based in Nevada.

To the fullest extent legally permitted, this Agreement is governed by Nevada law, and disputes that may lawfully be required to proceed in Nevada shall be brought in an appropriate Nevada court.

Nothing in this Agreement waives rights that cannot legally be waived under applicable law.

Out-of-state and international families remain responsible for determining whether participation is lawful and appropriate where they reside.

41. Limitation of Certain Damages

To the fullest extent permitted by law, Infinity will not be liable for indirect, incidental, special, punitive, exemplary, or consequential damages arising from participation in or inability to participate in the Self-Service program.

This provision does not limit liability where prohibited by law.

42. Severability

If any provision of this Agreement is found invalid or unenforceable, the remaining provisions will remain in effect to the extent legally permitted.

43. Entire Agreement

This Agreement, together with the Student's enrollment information, subscription selection, and applicable written promotional terms, constitutes the agreement between Infinity and the Parent regarding the Self-Service Homeschool Math Program.

A specific written promotional term controls only the provision it expressly modifies. Informal conversations or discretionary exceptions do not permanently amend this Agreement.

44. Updates to Policies

Infinity may update policies for future enrollment periods and may make reasonable administrative, technological, or academic updates during an active subscription when necessary for program operation, security, legal compliance, or educational integrity.

Infinity will not impose a materially different financial obligation for a future billing period without providing any notice required by applicable law.

PART XII. PARENT/GUARDIAN ACKNOWLEDGMENT

45. Parent/Guardian Acknowledgment

By electronically accepting this Agreement, the Parent acknowledges that:

1. The Parent has read, understands, and agrees to this Agreement on behalf of the Parent and Student.
2. Self-Service is a parent-led, self-paced curriculum program and does not include the regularly scheduled live instruction, attendance tracking, quarterly reporting, or teacher-managed grading provided through Infinity's Full-Service Homeschool program unless expressly stated otherwise.
3. The Parent understands the 11-unit course structure and the rolling three-unit access system, including that older units will close as new units open and that designated completed Unit Review materials will remain available while the subscription is active.
4. The Parent understands that supplemental videos may not be available for every lesson and that the video library may continue to develop during enrollment.
5. The Parent understands that the standard Self-Service subscription price is \$79 per month unless promotional pricing applies.

6. The Parent understands that the subscription continues from course to course unless canceled. If the Parent cancels before the Student completes the current course, one additional monthly payment will be due as the final payment. If the Parent elects to discontinue service upon completion of a course, no additional cancellation payment will be required.
7. The Parent understands that processed subscription payments are nonrefundable except where required by law.
8. The Parent understands that Infinity is not presently an accredited K-12 school or diploma-granting institution and is not the Student's legal school of record. The Parent remains responsible for applicable homeschool and education requirements.
9. The Parent agrees to protect Infinity's proprietary curriculum, answer keys, assessments, account access, and other materials and understands that the standard subscription is for the enrolled Student's education only.
10. The Parent understands that pods, microschools, schools, tutoring groups, and other multi-student uses require separate authorization or licensing from Infinity.
11. The Parent acknowledges that Infinity does not guarantee any particular academic or educational outcome.

The Parent acknowledges having had the opportunity to ask questions before enrollment.

Electronic Acceptance

Enrollment requires the Parent or legal guardian to affirmatively accept this Agreement through Infinity's online enrollment process.

You handle the homeschool. Infinity gives you the tools to teach the math.
